Market Alerts

TRANSITION – The movement of major growing areas from California to points as far south as Yuma Arizona is underway, and will continue through early December. “Transition”, as this is called, is a time when certain crops are more susceptible to disruptions in supply and quality. Be sure to read The Source Plus for up-to-date information and product recommendations.

AVOCADOS – Mexico’s harvest has resumed after a prolonged strike. It will take 2-3 weeks to replenish the supply chain with fully ripened, good quality fruit. Currently very little fruit is available, pricing is extremely high and quality is poor.

LETTUCE – Quality continues to be fair to poor on Iceberg and Romaine. Light weights, insect damage and dehydration are all reported. Pricing is higher on Romaine and Romaine Hearts, with Iceberg and Leaf being better overall values.

STRAWBERRIES – The wildfires in Southern California have disrupted the Strawberry harvest, creating short supplies. Pricing may be higher in certain markets, and quality is fair. Blackberries, Blueberries and Raspberries are all better values.

CAULIFLOWER – The Yuma, AZ harvest is off to a slow start, and supplies are tight. Quality is good, but pricing is higher than normal. Florets may be a better value than whole heads.

BELL PEPPERS – Field transition and rain in Georgia, Florida and California have limited supplies of **Green** and **Red Peppers**. Quality is good, but pricing is higher than normal. **Choice-grade Green Peppers** are the best cost option for the next few weeks.

TOMATOES – Mexico’s harvest continues to be light due to the recent hurricanes, and colder than expected temps. Quality is fair, and pricing is higher than normal, with Roma and Grape Tomatoes the most impacted. 5x6 and smaller Rounds are the best value..

A Peek at Peak Seasons

Berries: Quality of Blueberries, Blackberries and Raspberries are all very nice, with good availability.

Specialty Potatoes: – Quality is very good on all Colored, Fingerling, and Yukon Potatoes.

Pears: Quality is excellent out of Washington and California on all varieties.

Apples: All seasonal varieties are available, with great quality. 88 CT and larger sizes are the most plentiful. Small apples in the 125ct and smaller are limited in supply, especially with Granny Smith and Golden Delicious varieties.

Cranberries: Just in time for Thanksgiving menus, fresh Cranberries are in full harvest, with good quality reported.

Winter Squash: Butternut, Acorn, Delicata, Spaghetti and more are available – ask your distributor for recommendations!

Weather Update

California: The wildfires in Southern California continue to be severe, with strong winds expected most of the week.

Yuma, AZ: Colder than normal overnight temperatures continue.

Mexico: Temperatures warming slowly to normal levels over the week in Central Mexico.

Florida: Rain expected at the beginning of the week in the northern half of the state, followed by a very cold weather system. Inland temperatures will drop to the 30s.
